# NVR wraps up 2021 meetings, installation

Nevada REALTORS® honored leading members during its annual Installation Gala Friday night in northern Nevada at the Club at ArrowCreek's new events center. The state association honored long-time industry leader Brad Spires as its 2021 Nevada REALTOR® of the Year and recognized others from around the state for their continued service to their association, their profession and their communities.

In addition to announcing its annual industry award winners, the event honored Reno REALTOR® Doug McIntyre, who was installed as the 2022 NVR President. McIntyre is no stranger to leadership having served as the RSAR President in 2018. NVR's 2022 Board of Director members were also installed in advance of their upcoming year of service.

At its annual installation of officers and awards event, Nevada REALTORS® also presented awards to the following members:

• *Heidi Kasama* – REALTOR®

Active in Politics Award for government affairs advocacy. Kasama, of Las Vegas, is a state assemblywoman and was NVR's President in 2018. She was honored for playing a leading role in the association's initiatives supporting private property rights and other causes considered vital to the industry.

• *Jack Woodcock* — Nevada Distinguished REALTOR Award. Woodcock has been a long-time Broker/Realtor in Las Vegas. His award recognizes an individual among the membership who consistently contributes to the real estate profession and to NVR. His contributions span many years and are often in places where they are not be seen by the members.

• *Keith Lynam* – REALTOR® Achievement Award for outstanding service to local and state associations, as chosen by the state association president. Lynam, of Las Vegas, is a past president of NVR (2019).

• *Dave R. Tina* – Nolan/Reiss Award (formerly called the Joe Nolan Award and now also honoring longtime Las Ve-

gas REALTOR® Ronn Reiss) recognizing spirit, passion and professionalism in serving fellow REALTORS®. Tina is also a past president of LVR and NVR.

• *Robert Andy Stahl* — Inspiring New Leader of Tomorrow Award. Stahl, of Las Vegas, was honored for his considerable contributions so early in his career and for demonstrating strong leadership qualities.

NVR's annual December meeting also featured Program 4 and graduation ceremonies for its Leadership Academy. Additionally, the association held a Board Orientation for incoming 2022 BOD members and hosted its final BOD meeting of 2021. The meeting saw BOD members pass NVR's 2022 budget and featured distinguished guests like Kevin Sears, who is a candidate for the National Association of REALTORS® 1st VP for 2023, and Craig Sanford, who is a candidate for NAR Treasurer. Additionally, incoming Region XI RVP Rick Southwick was in attendance as well as a handful of past RVPs.
